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### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- 1. Applicants must have passed the HS or equivalent examinations recognized by the NBU authorities.
- 2. Applicants who have qualified in the year 2023, 2022 and 2021 are eligible to apply.
- 3. A student can apply for a maximum of three Major Courses, Two Minor Courses in a single application and Two Multi Disciplinary Courses for BA Stream, One Major Course for B.Com and Two Major Courses and Two Minor Courses for B.Sc Stream.
- 4. Reservation Rules of the West Bengal Govt. shall be strictly followed during admission.

  Students applying in reserved category shall ensure that they possess the requisite certificate duly issued by the SDO/BDO in their names / father's name and upload such certificate duringapplying to the college. The same rules apply for PH candidates applying in PH Category.

#### General eligibility criteria

A student will be allowed to take admission in the Major Course of B.A./B.Com./BBA/B.Sc./BCA if he/she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

Admission will be on merit and availability of seats, provided that for SC/ST Candidates, the minimum marks for eligibility will be as per rules of the State Government.

#### Provided however that:

- i. A candidate will be allowed to take up any subject except Computer Science, Microbiology, and such other interdisciplinary subjects in B.A./B.Com./BBA/B.Sc./BCA FYUG Program, if he/she/transgender has passed in the corresponding subject(s) at the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) recognized as equivalent by the University.
- ii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Sociology or Psychology or Education if he/she/transgender has passed in the previous qualifying examination of any stream.
- iii. A candidate will be allowed to take up B.Com. if he/she/transgender has studied Science subjects along with Mathematics in the previous qualifying exams.
- iv. A candidate will be allowed to take up Physics Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Chemistry along with Physics and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- v. A candidate will be allowed to take up Chemistry Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Physics along with Chemistry and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.

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- vi. A candidate will be allowed to take up Botany/Zoology Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- vii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Physiology subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biological Science and Chemistry at the qualifying examination.
- viii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Computer Science Subject if he/she/transgenderhas passed in Mathematics at the qualifying examination.
- ix. A candidate will be allowed to take up Microbiology Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying Examination.
- x. A candidate will be allowed to take up Economics as if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subjects as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- xi. No student other than those of Science stream and Economics/Geography of Arts stream will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.
- xii. No student of Arts and Commerce stream other than those of Geography and Economics will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.
- xiii. A candidate will be allowed to take up Geography subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Geography with other subjects at the qualifying examination.
- xiv. A candidate will be allowed to take up Geology subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at the qualifying examination.
- xv. A candidate will be allowed to take up Mass Communication and Journalism if he/she/transgender has passed in any Stream at the qualifying examination.
- xvi. A candidate will be allowed to take up BBA and BCA if he/she/transgender has passed in any Stream at the qualifying examination.
- xvii. A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.
- xviii. While taking Major & Minor subjects, availability of the said subjects in the concerned Colleges will be taken into cognizance.
- xix. A candidate pursuing Major in Economics will be awarded:
  - a. B.Sc. Major if he/she/transgender chooses atleast one subject from Mathematics or Statistics or Computer Science, as Minor. The other subject as Minor may be from the pool of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences subjects mentioned under Minor Courses of Appendix I.
  - B.A. Major if he/she/transgender chooses both the subjects as Minor from pool of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences mentioned under Minor Courses of Appendix

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xx. A candidate pursuing Major in Geography will be awarded:

- c. B.Sc. Major if he/she/transgender chooses at least one subject from the pool of Science subjects mentioned under Minor Courses of Appendix I, as Minor. The other subject as Minor may be from the pool of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences subjects mentioned under Minor Courses of Appendix I.
- d. B.A. Major if he/she/transgender chooses both the subjects as Minor from pool of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences mentioned under Minor Courses of Appendix

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### PROCESS OF ONLINE ADMISSION

1. Admission to all Major Courses will be based strictly on merit. Merit shall be calculated as per the following norms(for Major subject studied at +2 level):

Merit = [Marks obtained in English + Marks obtained in the subject opted for as Major + best marks of other two subjects {Excluding the subject opted for Major and English}] / 4

If the student does not have the specific subject opted for Major in his/her previous course, the procedure for Merit Calculation will be as follows:

Merit = [Marks obtained in English + Best Marks obtained in other three of subjects] / 4

- 2. The merit list of all eligible students shall be available on the college website (pmsm.org.in) and online admission Portal <a href="https://pmsmahavidyalayaadmission.in">https://pmsmahavidyalayaadmission.in</a>. This merit list will be prepared considering all students as General category students and also separate merit list for reserved category students. Students can also verify their positions in the merit list by logging into the college app which is- PARIMAL MITRA SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA (Download from Google Play Store)
- 3. Admissions to BA/B.COM/B.SC course shall take place by publication of Merit List of eligible students.
- 4. Students can take admission to a particular course at the first instance, and can very well change the option so exercised at a later stage based on score and position in the merit list.
- 5. Mere submission of application form does not guarantee admission to the college.
- 6. If at the time of final verification before the classes begin if it is found that the student has suppressed facts or submitted false documents his admission to the college shall stand cancelled.
- 7. All students of Higher Secondary (Vocational) Course, Open School [X+2 levels] shall be admitted only in the Three year Under Graduate Degree Course with Single Major.
  - 8. Applications seeking permission for admission by any candidate to any college affiliated to the University of North Bengal after the last date of online admission shall not be entertained by the University Authorities under any circumstances.
